The Haunted Labyrinth is a community building event providing service opportunities for youth in the Diocese of Providence. This fundraiser operates through the generous service of volunteers who are at least in eighth grade as of September 2017.

Please Bring:

- **A CURRENT SCHOOL ID; SCHOOL SCHEDULE; DRIVER'S LICENSE; IDENTIFICATION**
- If you would like, bring your own bottle of water (water will be given throughout the night); earplugs to guard against loud noises.
- Do not bring any valuable items. There is no place to store them. We are not responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Building:

- Please arrive (at the front door) no earlier than 6:15PM, and no later than 6:30PM.
- Have your ride pick you up at 9:30PM! If you are leaving early, a parent or guardian must come in to pick you up.
- Please wear clothes that you don't mind getting paint on or getting ripped or snagged.
- No open-toed shoes are allowed. Please wear sneakers or work boots.

Scaring:

- Please arrive at the Rejoice in Hope Youth Center in Cranston (at the back door) no earlier than 5:15PM and no later than 5:30PM. Doors will open at 5:30 PM. Haunted Labyrinth is open from 7:00PM until 10:00PM! Plan on being picked up (at the front door) no later than 10:30PM.
- **YOU MUST BE DRESSED IN BLACK.** Remember the motto: "All black all the time!" Please dress in long pants and long-sleeved shirts! No open-toed shoes allowed! If you are not dressed appropriately, you may be asked to return another night when dressed properly. Do not bring any masks or costumes. These will be supplied. We will supply you with everything you need once you are assigned a spot.
- There will be an adult Security person assigned to your area, who will check on you regularly.

What working at the Haunted Labyrinth will do for you:

- It will give you opportunities for fun, community building and prayer.
- It will broaden your friendships throughout the Diocese.
- It will help you develop a better understanding of discipleship and service to others.
- It will expect that you work and act according to the example of Christ.
